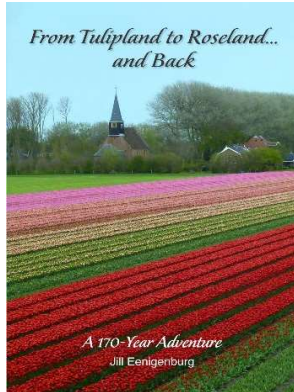


From Tulipland to Roseland... and Back
